

College of Science



The College of Science was founded in 1955 and located on the Gong-Guan campus where covers more than ten hectares. Currently the College of Science is comprised of five departments: Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Earth Sciences, and Computer Science & Information Engineering; Three independent Graduate Institutes: Environmental Education, Science Education, and Marine Environmental Science. We have established Professional School of Life Science in 2018 that provides interdisciplinary subjects. Training programs are provided at both undergraduate and graduate levels and B.Sc., M.Sc. and Ph.D. degrees are offered.

There are 177 faculty members, 48 supporting staff, 1537 undergraduate students and 1327 graduate students in the College. They are joined by a total 74 international students. Most of the international students are supported by NTNU partial tuition scholarships and scholarships from the Taiwan government. In addition to academic programs, students enjoy many traditional Chinese activities arranged by the Office of International Affairs (OIA), student societies, and The Mandarin Training Center (MTC) of NTNU.

The College of Science aims to nurture outstanding scientific and technological talents and to cultivate secondary school science teachers in parallel. The curricula are designed to prepare students for careers in a wide range of interdisciplinary fields in natural science. The cultivation and education of students is set out in accordance with curriculum maps to help students enrich their professional knowledge and skills for future career development. Faculty and teaching staffs are actively engaged in research and teaching that provides an ideal learning environment on campus. Research results are published in internationally renowned journals. The College of Science has built strong bond with partner Universities worldwide that provide students with better international opportunities.

Among the many outstanding alumni, there are five academicians at Academia Sinica, with many others are currently holding important positions within both academia and industry circles. Our alumni network continues to grow and these links help encourage more students to study at the College, while also broadening the career development opportunities for our graduates.
