Introduction

The Department of Adult & Continuing Education was established in 1955.

The master's program was set up in 1985 and was followed by a doctoral program in 1995. The undergraduate program encompasses four major learning areas:

- (1) Creative Design for Adult Learning
- (2) Program Design and Media Production
- (3) Innovation and Diffusion of Social and Cultural Industries
- (4) Organizational Learning and Management

The master's program has two subfields: 1) Adult and Continuing Education and 2) Management of Social Enterprises and Cultural Industries. An extension program is provided for adult learners from social education institutions, non-profit organizations, and school systems.



Instructional Objectives

The educational goal of this department is to cultivate students with humanitarian spirit, social responsibility, and cultural perspectivism for social education, social advocacy and educational leadership in an evolving and globalized society.

The educational vision is embodied in the pursuit of excellent faculty, rigorous curriculum, multiple career development lines, and professional competencies.

Degree Requirements

The Department of Adult & Continuing Education offers three degree programs: Bachelor, M. Ed. and Ph.D. For in-service students, we also provide a graduate-level academic program: In-service Master Program.
