Founded in 2018, the School of Learning Informatics aims to integrate relevant academic programs in the field of Learning Sciences and Information in NTNU. The main office is located in the Education Building inside NTNU Main Campus II (also known as Library Campus).

The School of Learning Informatics is consisted of one undergraduate program and two post-graduate programs, including Program of Learning Sciences, Graduate Institute of Information and Computer Education and Graduate Institute of Library and Information Studies.
