Enrollment Regulations for Courses on Chinese Thinking and Expression

Revised on the 1st Academic Affairs Meeting of the 2019 Academic Year on October 30th, 2019

English Translation finalized on July 29th, 2022

Article 1 To elevate the thinking and expression skills of undergraduate students of National Taiwan Normal University (hereinafter referred to as “the University”), the University has prescribed the *National Taiwan Normal University Enrollment Regulations for Courses on Chinese Thinking and Expression* (hereinafter referred to as “the Regulations”).

Article 2 Undergraduate students studying in the University shall be required to enroll in the courses of *Chinese Reading and Thinking* and *Chinese Writing and Expression*, each with two (2) credits.

Article 3 Students are free to enroll in *Chinese Reading and Thinking* and *Chinese Writing and Expression* through the course selection system during the course add/drop period. In principle, the course selection period for first-year students will be determined by their department.

Article 4 During their study at the University, international students may enroll in four (4) credits of Chinese language courses in lieu of enrollment in *Chinese Reading and Thinking* and *Chinese Writing and Expression*. Course selection methods for international students and the required competence-based class grouping for their Chinese language courses shall be announced separately.

Article 5 Matters not discussed in these Regulations shall be handled in accordance with the University’s *School Regulations* and any relevant laws and regulations.

Article 6 These Regulations, and any ensuing revisions, shall be implemented following its passage at an Academic Affairs Council meeting.
