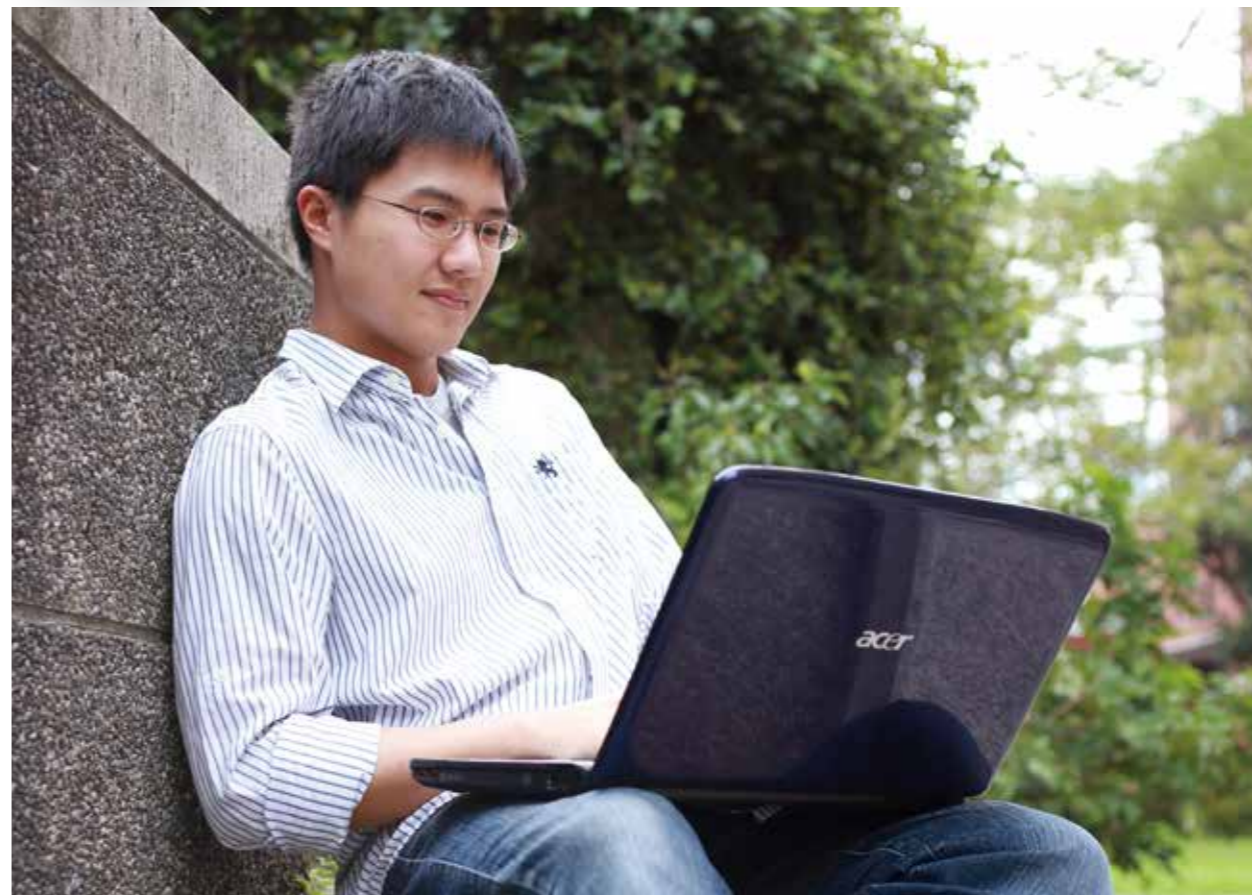


Graduate Institute of Educational Policy and Administration
