Required	Alien Resident Certificate	International students and overseas Chinese students must prepare the required documents within 30 days after entry, while students from Hong Kong and Macau must do so within three months after entry, and apply for the Alien Resident Certificate on the Immigration Agency's website.	
	Work Permit	International students and overseas Chinese students must first apply for a work permit if you wish to work in Taiwan, whether on- campus or off-campus.	Office of International Affairs
	International Student Insurance	 Students who are not yet qualified for the National Health Insurance system should visit the Office of International Affairs to enroll in a student group medical insurance plan. Mandatory insurance for any person who has resided in Taiwan for a period of 6 months. (Foreign nationals who with Valid ARC for Taiwan area must be registered in the National Health Insurance program upon living in Taiwan for 6 months.) Insurance coverage for the fall semester runs from September to February of the following year. Coverage for the spring semester runs from March to August.
