2025 9th NTNU Sports Literature and Photography Award Guidelines

A. Categories

- 1. Chinese Prose
- 2. English Prose
- 3. Sports Photography

B. Eligibility

- 1. Chinese and English Prose: All students enrolled in National Taiwan Normal University for 114-1 Semester (including degree students, exchange students, visiting students, students under the Dual Study Program, and students in the autumn session of MTC).
- 2. Sports Photography: All students enrolled in NTNU, NTU and NTUST for 114-1 Semester (including degree students, exchange students, visiting students, students under the Dual Study Program, and students in the autumn session of MTC).

C. Submission Duration

2025.10.20~202511.14 12:00 p.m.

D. Regulation of Each Category

- 1. Chinese Prose
 - I. Submitted works must be related to sports.
 - II. The word count should be between 1,500-2,500 words, and the works must be written in Chinese.
 - III. Each person can submit a maximum of three works, and one will be selected on the best basis.
 - IV. The file format should be in PDF and Word, with the content in A4 size with single line spacing, 14-point font, and in "KaiTi" font.
- 2. Submission Method: Fill out the Google form
 (https://
) and upload the file with the name of the category, name and work title (e.g. 中文散文組-黃大明-我的運動生涯). Works that do not meet the above requirements will not be accepted for judging.
- 3. English Prose
 - I. Submitted works must be related to sports.
 - II. The word count should be between 500-1,000 words, and the works must be written in English.
 - III. Each person can submit a maximum of three works, and one will be selected on the best basis.
 - IV. The file format should be in PDF and Word, with the content in A4 size with single line spacing, 14-point font, and in "Times New Roman" font.
 - V. Submission Method: Fill out the Google form (https://) and upload the file with the name of the

category, name and work title (e.g. English Prose-Andy Gran-Badminton and I). Works that do not meet the above requirements will not be accepted for judging.

3. Sports Photography

- I. Submitted works must be related to sports.
- II. The "original digital files" of the entries should be in digital format with a file size of "8 million pixels or more" or "pixels 3200*2100dpi or more" in JPG format. Files should not be artificially enlarged. Entries should not have frames added, color adjustments, computer-generated compositions or alterations, hand coloring, compositing, stacking, combining, or series submissions. Cropping is allowed.
- III. In order to protect your rights and respect the person being photographed, it is recommended that participants must request permission from the individual being photographed in advance.
- IV. Works that do not meet the above requirements will not be accepted for judging. If there is any controversy about software modification or synthesis, the decision will be guided by the opinion of the experts invited by the organizing team.
- V. Each person can submit a maximum of six works, and one will be selected on the best basis. (except for popularity award)
- VI. Submission Method: Fill out the Google form (https://) and upload the file with the name of the category, name and work title (e.g. Sports Photography-Andy Gran-Badminton and I). Works that do not meet the above requirements will not be accepted for judging.

E. Evaluation Criteria

- 1. Chinese Prose: Theme (40%), Article Structure (30%), Rhetoric (30%)
- 2. English Prose: Theme (40%), Article Structure (30%), Rhetoric (30%)
- 3. Sports Photography: Theme and Explanation (30%), Composition and Aesthetics (30%), Creativity (40%)
- 4. Sports Photography Popularity Award
 - Within 3 days after submission, the organizer will publish the entries on the Facebook album and Instagram account of "NTNU Love Sports" and open it for "likes" and "loves", participants are encouraged to submit their entries as early as possible.
 - Judged by the total number of "likes" and "loves" clicked below the photo in Facebook albums and Instagram accounts.
 - From now until 12:00 noon on November 21, 2025, the top three photos with "likes" and "loves" will be awarded the popularity award.
 - Illegal purchase of likes, zombie accounts, plug-ins, etc. are not allowed. During the competition period, if a participant is reported to have any illegal situation that affects the fairness of the competition, he/she will be disqualified from the competition after the organizer has confirmed the facts by contacting the person in question, and the participant will not be allowed to challenge the decision.
